

Steps for Stewardship Planning

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1. Begin with public input, including input from all stakeholders.
2. Determine goals and objectives.
3. Hold public meetings so that the public can review these goals and objectives.
4. Gather information about the forest, conduct surveys/inventories as needed.
5. Seek professional assistance from multiple resource professionals.
6. Re-evaluate options, goals and objectives.
7. Draft a management plan.
8. Hold another round of public meetings for management plan review.
9. Revise as needed.
10. Seek DCNR review.
11. With approval, implement long-term plan.

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
