Possible WWNC* Management Goals:

- 1. Preserve an older growth forest (derived from BOF latest plan for PA forests).
- 2. Preserve a unique (and rare in PA forest lands) natural area.
- 3. Attend to DCNR climate adaption and mitigation goals.
- 4. Secure a carbon sequestration contract.
- 5. Promote ease of use by human visitors.
- 6. Foster growth of native species.
- 7. Develop a 15-100 year plan to control invasive species that relies, in part, on volunteer participation including volunteer reduction of garden-use of invasive plants.
- 8. Support DCNR Plan Recreation for All.
- 9. Support DCNR Wildlife Action Plan by preserving habitat for species of "greatest conservation need."
- 10. Expand WWNC use as educational facility; provide training for student and community volunteers.
- 11. Expand WWNC use as a center for Indiana Region community connections.
- 12. Preserve the WWNC role in stormwater mitigation.
- 13. Establish permanent mechanisms for citizen input.

*WWNC is a Project 70 Land to be used for conservation, recreations, and historical preservation and was originally designated as land to be left largely in its natural state. It is to remain as a natural area.
